Dorm Rooms

- I. The dorm rooms are designed to be doubles, furnished with two beds with twin mattresses, two desks, two desk chairs, two wardrobes, one bookshelf, and two power strips (surge protectors).
 - a. Students may arrange the furniture as they like, but there must be an unobstructed, straight path from the door to the window for safe egress in an emergency.
- II. Students are encouraged to bring personal decorations as long as they reflect good taste and the moral values of the school. Wall decorations must be put up with wall putty or a reusable adhesive (not nails or tacks). Decorations containing references (posters or objects) to alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or sexuality are not permitted.
- III. Students may have one miniature refrigerator per room.
- IV. Students may not bring pets of any kind to the dorm.
- V. Students are expected to maintain clean rooms.
 - a. All lights, computers, and musical devices should be turned off when students are not present.
 - b. Residential Faculty will perform Room Check once per week.
 - c. Students who fail Room Check will be given extra chores.
- VI. Damage to the room will be charged to a student's account (including window screens). If no individual responsibility is claimed by a particular resident, the charges will be divided equally between both occupants of the room.
- VII. In the event that a suspicion exists that a school rule has been violated or that a student may be in possession of prohibited items or stolen goods, the student's room may be searched at any time without notice. If any prohibited items or stolen goods are found, they will be confiscated and the student and his/her parents will be notified as soon as is reasonably possible.
